

- Archery GB cards:** Current Archery GB membership cards / e-cards will be required for inspection at registration
- Photography:** Anyone wishing to take photographs should register with the tournament organiser

- Dress code:** Archery GB dress regulations (rule 307) will apply — *in particular, garments may not be blue denim or camouflage pattern*
- Refreshments:** Light refreshments will be available

† Archers who are eligible when they enter but improve their classification to Indoor B2 or above by the day of the shoot may still shoot, but will not be eligible for awards
