**Rounds:** World Archery 900 round [30 arrows each 60m+50m+40m] (seniors)  
AGB 900 50 round [30 arrows each 50m+40m+30m] (juniors U18)  
AGB 900 40 round [30 arrows each 40m+30m+20m] (juniors U16)  
AGB 900 30 round [30 arrows each 30m+20m+10m] (juniors U14)

*Archers are welcome to shoot rounds longer or shorter than those indicated for their age group, but those shooting shorter alternatives will be eligible only for handicap-adjusted awards*

**Sighters:** 12:00 noon (last registration 11:30am)  
**Archery GB cards:** Current Archery GB membership cards / e-cards will be required for inspection at registration

**Photography:** Anyone wishing to take photographs should register with the tournament organiser
